


Create a Facebook Account

1 Create An Email Account

A working email address is required for every Facebook account. If you do not already have one, you must create an email account first.

The form to create an account on Facebook is available on their homepage.



3 Fill in the Required Information

When you sign up, Facebook asks you for personal information, including your gender, birthday, and email address. After you've created your account, you can always change your settings so that this information isn't public.

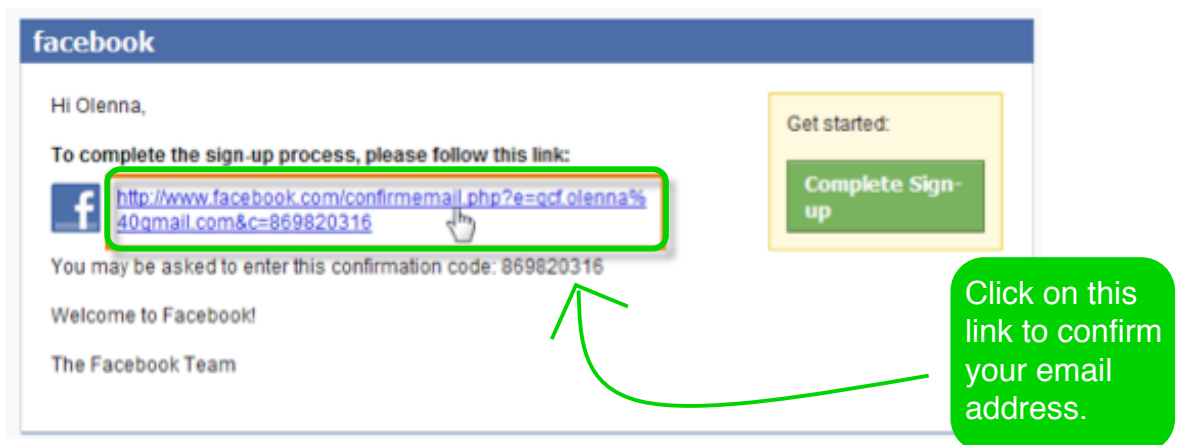

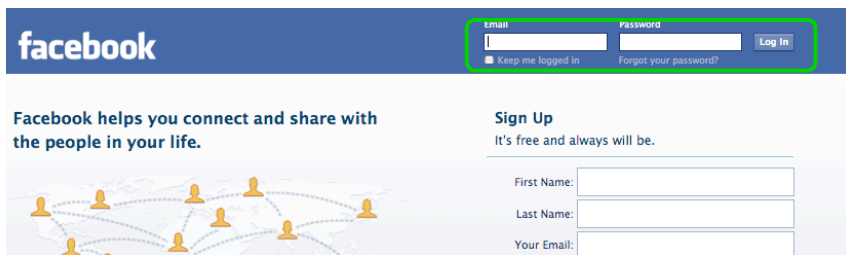
6 Confirm Your Email Address

You're done! Now you can sign into your facebook account from any computer with internet access. Just go to www.facebook.com and fill in your your email address and new, Facebook password at the top of the page.

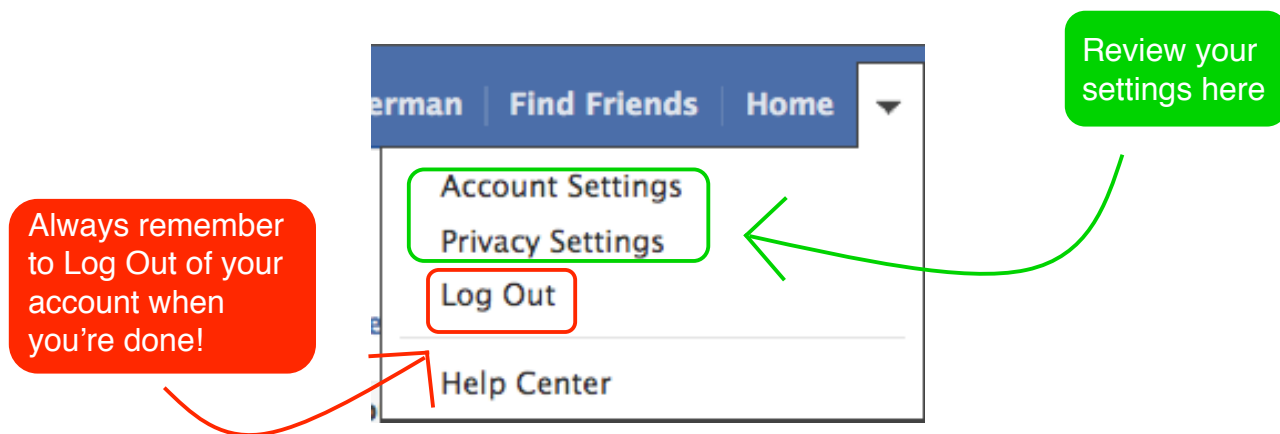
