Happy New Year!

Here's hoping that 2026 will be another GREAT year of having volunteers in Crete!

Let me tell you a little about an organization that has been in Crete since 1999. Angels on Assignment is an all-volunteer run organization that's based right here in Crete. We help families that are dealing with serious illness, with a focus on children. It was started by a group of businesspeople and caring citizens who realized that they could raise funds and help those who need it most by helping with medical bills, gas cards and other things that may make life a little easier during a very stressful time in their lives.

In 2009, we started a Christmas toy drive that assisted families in Crete with Christmas presents. These items went to another organization that disbursed them. In 2021, Angels on Assignment decided to disburse them on their own to Crete Township children in the Crete-Monee School District. Every year, donations have increased, and the number of children we help has grown.

In 2020, the Santa Sleigh Parade started, and a wonderful new tradition began. Santa and his elves ride around Crete and picks up donations of toys and food for Angels and the Crete Food Pantry. This boosted donations 100%. A lot more families were served by both the Crete Food Pantry and Angels on Assignment Toy Drive.

In 2025, something remarkable happened. Stan Pacocha, owner of Roxann Sports Bar wanted to donate \$1,000 worth of bikes! Word got out, and next the Crete Fire Department Association wanted to match Stan's generous donation. From there, donations kept coming in! The total donation of bikes grew to 45!

This year, Angels on Assignment distributed toys to 36 families with 125 children. We gave away all 45 bikes to Crete Township children. It was a great day!

This all took hundreds of wonderful volunteers! People with BIG HEARTS who just wanted to make kids SMILE!!!!

Thank you, Crete, for all your hard work in making this happen!

Ghantel's dedication to education spans more than two decades, beginning as a 3rd grade teacher and progressing to Assistant Principal, Principal,

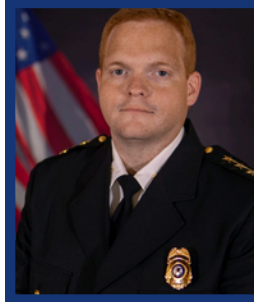

Exciting New Programs and Events at Crete Township Community Center

Here’s a glimpse of the thrilling new 2026 programs and events on the horizon for the Crete Township Community Center:



Crete Kids Club: A before-and-after-school program designed for school-age children (full-time kindergartners and older). Opening on February 1, 2026, hours are Monday to Friday from 6 AM to 9 AM and 2 PM to 6 PM. During school holidays and summer vacations, the program will run from 6 AM to 6 PM.



Rock Revolution: A youth music program tailored for students aged 11-18, focusing on instrument instruction, music theory, and performance across guitar, keyboard, percussion, bass, and vocals. Crete Township is seeking experienced instructors.



STEM Program for Youth: In collaboration with Mentoring Youth Through Technology (MYTT), the Crete Township Youth Commission will offer “STEM” programming for youth ages 6-18. This includes opportunities in Robotics, Coding, Game Development, Virtual Reality, Media Production, Youth Innovations, Drone activities, Mentoring, Internships, and an Entrepreneur’s Club. Workshops and camps will commence in February 2026.



1st Annual Epic Collectibles Extravaganza: Taking place on March 13-14, this event is co-hosted with The Closet Collectibles and will feature a collectibles expo with vendors from across the Midwest, showcasing a variety of popular collectibles, including Lego, Hot Wheels, Superheroes, Pokémon, Barbie, Marvel, GI Joe, Matchbox, and much more.

Important Winter Reminders From Your Friends at Code Enforcement

For residents, here are some **vital** reminders from the Code Enforcement Department:

Do Not: throw, push, blow, or deposit snow from your property onto any streets or alleys.

Be sure to remove snow and ice from sidewalks and walkways adjacent to your property.

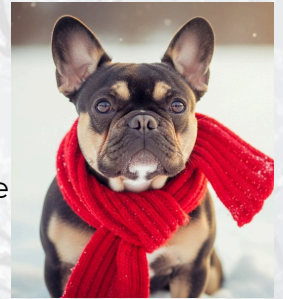
In an emergency, please help by ensuring that fire hydrants near your home are clear of snow.

Remember: 2 inches of snow, do not park on the street or alleyways.

Ensuring the Safety of Our Furry Residents

With winter right around the corner, here are some winter tips to keep your furry friends safe this winter season.

Limit outdoor time in cold weather, and ensure walks are short. Bring pets inside if they shiver or lift their paws. Stay visible on night walks with LED collars or reflective vests to alert drivers. Keeping your pet's paws protected for walks or even just potty breaks is essential.



Avoid areas such as roads and areas treated with rock salt and de-icing chemicals, which can cause burns to your pet's paws. If such contact does happen, make sure to wipe paws with a damp towel or unscented baby wipe after each walk or potty break to remove salt and chemicals. Or if able and available, use paw booties for extra protection. Also, make sure to monitor your pet's paws for any cracks or wounds, and contact your veterinarian if wounds or cracks appear for treatment and guidance. Using pet-safe de-icers for your driveways and sidewalks can lessen the exposure your pets will encounter.

Safety Tips from Crete Emergency Management Agency

Crete E.M.A. reminds residents to stay prepared for winter weather by assembling an emergency kit with warm clothing, blankets, flashlights, batteries, and non-perishable food. Keep your vehicle winter-ready with a full gas tank, emergency supplies, and proper tires, and stay informed by monitoring local weather alerts. At home, prepare for winter by insulating pipes, sealing drafts, stocking essential medications, and ensuring you have extra water and shelf-stable food in case travel becomes difficult. Remember to check on neighbors—especially older adults—and limit non-essential travel during severe winter conditions to help keep everyone safe. **For more information, please scan the QR code.**

Kits go quickly, so don't miss out! We can't wait to see all your tiny art!

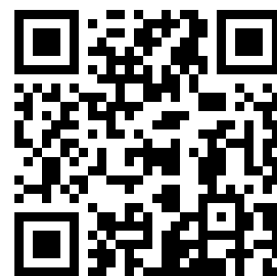


Another Successful Mitten Tree!
